NON-PROFIT CORPORATE BYLAWS

ARTICLE I

NAME

1.01 Name

The name of this corporation shall be the Fund for American Seafarers, Inc. The business of the corporation may be conducted as Fund for American Seafarers or American Seafarers Fund.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES AND POWERS

2.01 Purpose

The Fund for American Seafarers, Inc. is a non-profit corporation and shall be operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.

The Fund for American Seafarers, Inc. purpose is to raise money for expedition style seafaring based programs to fund capital projects and provide scholarship money so youth of all financial strata are able to attend expedition seafaring education and development programs regardless of financial ability.

We raise awareness about the gaps in the education system by utilizing social media channels and the corporation's website to provide studies, facts, references, and other related data on the benefit of expedition seafaring summer programs for fostering critical life-skills (ex. character, grit, functional optimism, team-work, communication skills) that are unable to be taught in current classroom settings.

Our programs include sending out ambassadors to raise social consciousness about the cause on a local, regional and national level, and to hold fundraising events in order to provide capital funding for expedition style seafaring based education and development programs and scholarship funding for youth that do not have the financial ability to attend the same programs on their own.

To maximize our impact on current efforts, we may seek to collaborate with other non-profit organizations which fall under the 501(c) (3) section of the internal revenue code and are operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes.
